REPORTING SCORES for U9's and U11's:

The *home* team will be required to get the white copies of the game sheets of both teams from the referee at the end of the game along with any trialist or permission forms. Score sheets for both teams are to be sent *within 24 hours by one of the following*:

- 1. take photos with your cell phone, one game sheet per photo and email only to ewzsagamesheets@shaw.ca and gamesheets@ewzsa.com.
- 2. or scan the sheets in PDF format and email only to ewzsagamesheets@shaw.ca and gamesheets@ewzsa.com. When scanning please put only one game sheet per page.

Game Score Submission Instructions:

The <u>home team</u> will be required to log into the EMSA West Soccer Portal and enter the game score by the next morning after the game. Only coaches, assistant coaches and managers who are registered on the team's roster can be scorekeepers.

Rounds: Community U9 and U11 teams:

There are three rounds, allowing for two tiering rounds. It is really important in order to correctly tier the teams, that all scores are posted to the EMSA West Soccer Portal and gamesheets are submitted to ewzsagamesheets@shaw.ca and gamesheets@ewzsa.com, especially at the end of each round so we can prepare the next set of schedules.

<u>Postponed/Rained-out/AQI Games</u> should be made up as soon as possible. Leaving them until the last minute can cause problems if the weather turns bad at the end of the Round! Forfeited/defaulted games must be reported within 24 hours.

<u>Choosing a Field for Practice or for Make-up Games</u>: Field permits are for Monday through Thursday, some Friday evenings and Sundays from 5-9 p.m.

If you cancel your game, also cancel your referee with the assignor.

Win. Tie. Loss Values:

- 3 points are awarded for a win
- 1 for a tie
- 0 for a loss

<u>Defaults</u> occur when one team arrives at the field and the other team does not.

For U9's and older, unless there is a signed game sheet to indicate a "Default" has occurred, the statistician will record the game as never having been played with no points to either team. A legitimate default is counted as a 5-0 win. Remember- Preliminary Rounds stats are used to place teams into the Second Rounds. If you declare a "Default" wi , this may skew your stats and cause your team to be placed higher than they should be in the following round.

U11 Teams going to city finals will be determined based on their stats in the final round. Coach will need to complete a post season commitment form – online by June 7th.

Posting of Stats: Stats and scores will be posted for U9/U11's (3 rounds) to www.emsawest.com. Occasionally scores get reversed by referees, recorded incorrectly, game sheets are not handed in, or scans are illegible so please, each coach or manager must check the standings for accuracy and report any problems to Chris.
