## EWZSA Policy

### **Title: Club Trialist Policy**

### **Policy Statement:**

This policy is set in place to provide a guideline for any Club official within the Edmonton North Boundary who is looking to recruit trialists from community teams.

If a club official (team official, trainer or otherwise) would like to use a community player as a trialist for some Club games, prior to approaching the coach to sign off on the EMSA Main Trialist form, they must first request permission to approach via the EMSA West Office and cc the Community Coordinator. ### **The request in the email shall include the following information:**

- Name of Player(s)
- Age Group & Division of Player
- Name of Team Player is currently on
- Name of Team/Club/Age Group/Division requesting trialist
- Specify the games the Club would like to use the Trialist for

The EMSA West office is required to follow up with the Community Co-Ordinator on all requests and report back to the club within 72 hours with an answer. Any requests that cannot be fulfilled must be provided with a reason.

**This policy does NOT replace the EMSA Trialist Form. Once a community guest player is approved by EMSA West, the Trialist form must still be completed in order for the player to participate.**

**Purpose:** The purpose of this policy is to create transparency and cooperation between the EMSA North Boundary Clubs and the EMSA West Community Program.
